Taught in differentiated small groups, SIPPS takes a structured literacy approach to foundational skills instruction through explicit routines focused on phonological/phonemic awareness, spelling-sound correspondences, and high-frequency words.

SIPPS Levels (Beginning, Extension, and Challenge) each correspond to a specific stage of reading development: simple alphabetic, spelling-pattern, and polysyllabic/morphemic. Beginning and Extension Levels include program-specific student decodable texts that provide practice with the skills and concepts taught in SIPPS. We know that additional fluency practice is essential for students to solidify their accuracy and automaticity, and Geodes provides valuable supportive texts while also building students' knowledge of topics encompassing science, history, the arts, and more.




