

Students who moved into the district mid-to late-year-without exposure to our Tier 1 and Tier 2 instruction- presented with incoming data nearly identical to baseline data from our students in the fall. By the end of the year, these students' performance were indistinguishable from peers.





Eliminate the Learning Gap

District wide, only 2% of students finish the year in the underperforming range for letter/sound identification, and 1% are underperforming in phonemic awareness-this includes mid-year move-ins and students with IEPs.

Students Entering First Grade with Strong Foundational Skills

Kindergarten students are moving to first grade having mastered letter and sound identification, phoneme blending and segmenting, and reading CVC words. These essential skills set them up for success in first grade and beyond.
