## **SESSION OVERVIEW**

In this one-day session, teachers who are transitioning from *Eureka Math*<sup>®</sup> to *Eureka Math*<sup>2</sup> will investigate the similarities and differences between the structure, design, and components of the two curricula while engaging with *Eureka Math*<sup>2</sup> print and digital resources. Teachers will explore the instructional role of all the curriculum resources (including *Eureka Math*<sup>2</sup> *Equip*<sup>M</sup> for those who also adopt the premium assessment tool) and be prepared to facilitate lessons with students.

## **SESSION OBJECTIVES**

Participants will:

- Explain the importance of teaching math as a story.
- Describe how the structure of *Eureka Math*<sup>2</sup> modules, topics, and lessons facilitates teaching math as a story.
- Experience and give examples of how the components and design of *Eureka Math*<sup>2</sup> lessons facilitate engagement, teachability, and accessibility, and meet the learning variability needs that naturally exist in every classroom.
- Access *Eureka Math*<sup>2</sup> assessment and digital resources and explain how the resources are used to support effective instruction.
