

COACHING

Overview:

Guided by a *PhD Science*[®] coach, educators in a small group coteach to analyze and customize a selected lesson. Participants either coteach the lesson or observe the cotaught lesson. The whole group debriefs the lesson through objective analysis of how the instruction affected student learning. Together, the group decides on adjustments to the lesson that will likely improve student outcomes and will support teachers to carry best practices into future instruction.

Session Goals:

- Improve teaching practice by enabling teachers to collaboratively plan and deliver a lesson.
- Explore a professional learning process that school communities can own and use repeatedly to nurture steady improvement in classroom practices.
- Engage in collaborative study, analysis, preparation, and debriefing of lessons.
- Implement a process for investigating best practices for science instruction.
